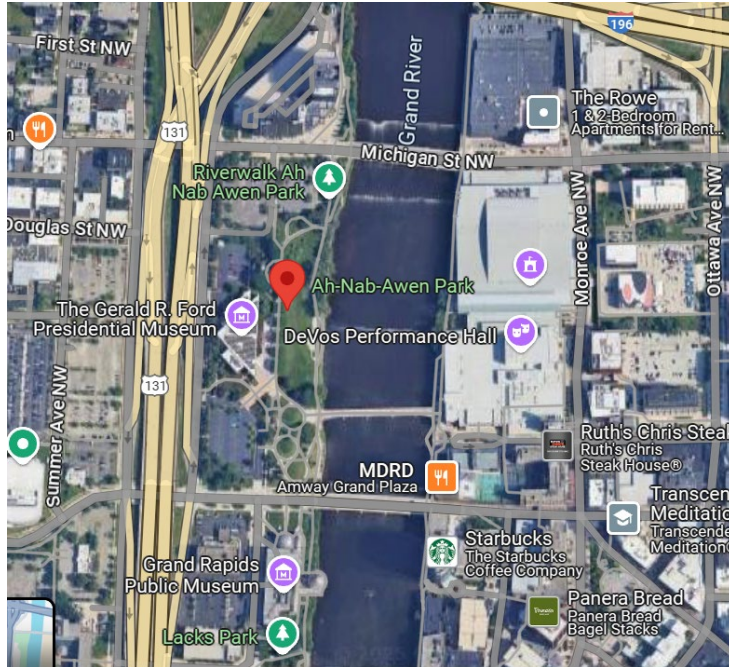
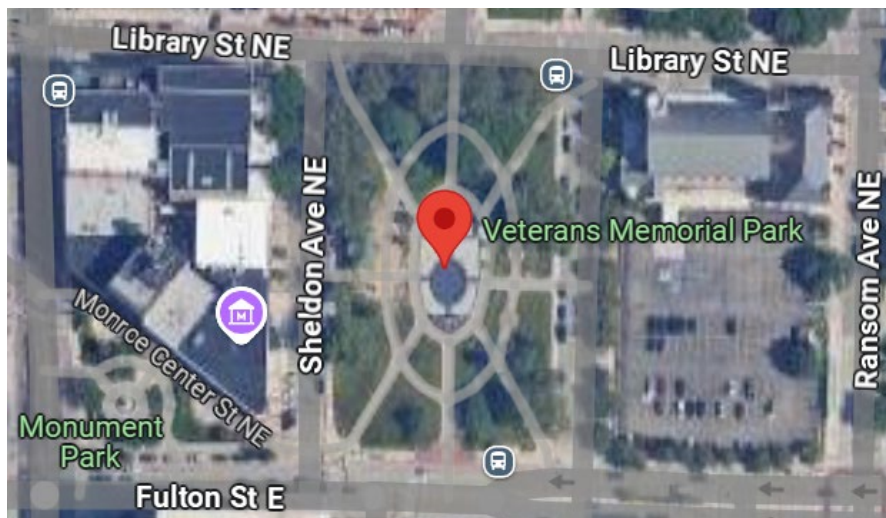

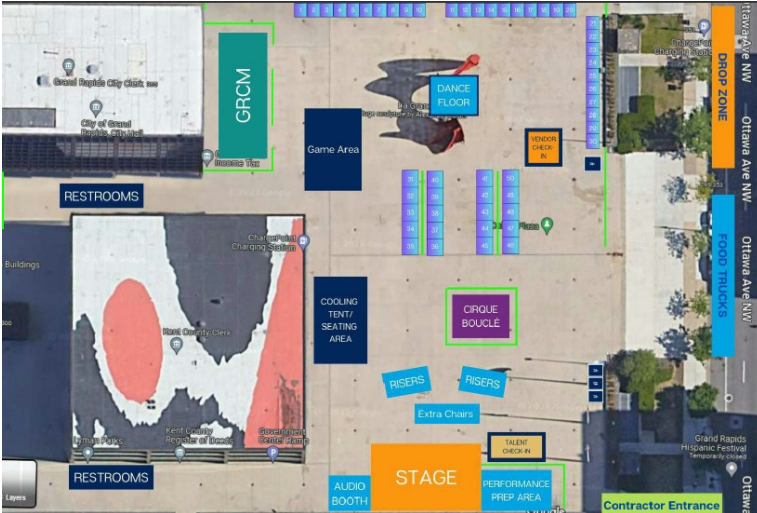

Riverbank Events is requesting a Special Event Permit for a commercial-grade firework display culminating the Grand Rapids Family Fireworks event on Saturday, July 5, 2025. The commercial-grade fireworks will be discharged by a licensed pyrotechnic between 10:00 PM and 11:00 PM from the Gillette Bridge (Inter-Urban Bridge- public property) located between the Amway Grand Plaza Hotel and Ah-Nab-Awen Park in Grand Rapids or the 555 Monroe North Lot or another approved location due to the river restoration. All necessary documentation will be submitted in advance to the Grand Rapids Fire Department and GRFD along with GRPD will approve the location, setup, and discharge, and be onsite to monitor the display.
