SUBJECT: **Resolution authorizing an agreement with Corewell Health for on-site health care for a total amount not to exceed \$30,000**

This is a follow-up item to the City Commission approval of partnering with Priority Health for health insurance administration on September 19, 2023. Contained within the bid from Priority Health was the option to include on-site nursing care with a Registered Nurse (RN). This offer includes eight (8) hours per week, and more hours can be utilized if needed. The RN would be able to perform the following tasks for employees:

- Clinical interventions and one-on-one consultations
- Biometric screenings (blood pressure, temperature, glucose, cholesterol, etc.)
- Health and wellness education
- Healthcare navigation assistance for employees
- Training for how to use on-site virtual care kiosks currently deployed at the City

Services provided by the on-site RN are free to employees. The City's Human Resources Department recommends participating in this offer as it will improve employee health and wellbeing, increase access to medical services, promote a culture of health equity, and help identify gaps in care and early intervention.

The term of this agreement would last for one year. If the program has proven to be successful and beneficial, additional approval to continue the agreement will be requested at the end of the one-year agreement.

Funding for this will be through the Internal Service Fund's contractual services of Fund 6770 (Health).
